Narrative & Location
<p><b>Narrative:</b></p> <p>On 8/23/2019, Vieira Custom Spraying sent in a notice of intent for [REDACTED], to spray YUKON (dicamba) on site 07-103 which is Sorghum For/Fod. However while checking the NOI, Inspector Jose Lopez stated that to the southwest of the field is cotton. He called to verify with the grower that it was in fact cotton as well. On the recommendation a map was attached with the surrounding crops labeled wrong. Where the cotton is planted the PCA wrote Corn. The Yukon label specifically states "COTTON Buffer Zones: 1. Aerial applications shall not be made closer than 1 mile from cotton. 2. Ground applications shall not be made closer than 1 mile from cotton unless wind direction during the application is away from cotton. When wind direction during the ground application is away from cotton, ground applications shall not be made closer than 1/2 mile from cotton." Also, the site was written for sorghum f/f but at the time did not have sorghum on the site. The application was denied because of both reasons, spraying Yukon within the mile as well as sorghum not being active on the site. The PCA should have noted for the Pest Control Business that cotton was close or within 1 mile of the site and can only do it if the wind direction is in favor. Since the map state it was corn and no other additional notes besides "beware of surrounding crops" were on the recommendation, it is a violation.</p>
