
**SUMMARY OF EXPOSURE EPISODE (Use Pesticide Episode Investigation Supplemental Report if Additional Space is Needed)**

I received Pesticide Incident report # 2017-1482 on December 5, 2017.  
 I called the phone number on file on December 5, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. \_\_\_\_\_ answered the phone. She said that she is \_\_\_\_\_ wife. I asked her if I could speak to her husband, but she said that he was not present. I asked her if she was present when the incident occurred, and if she was able to answer some questions about the incident. She stated that she was home the day in question. \_\_\_\_\_ said that the incident happened early in the morning. On Saturday December 2, 2017 \_\_\_\_\_ was doing some yard work. \_\_\_\_\_ said that they have a drought resistant yard, but that once in awhile they get weeds emerging from the cracks and gravel. \_\_\_\_\_ was treating the weeds with Spectracide weed and grass killer at around 9:00 a.m., he was using a face mask. She called her husband in to have breakfast, and when he came inside the home he was constantly sneezing. She said that he did not eat his breakfast and mentioned to her that he did not feel very well. \_\_\_\_\_ said that she had to take her son to dance class, but when she returned home at around 11:30 a.m. she was scared when she saw her husband. She said that his face was completely red, his body was covered in rashes, and he was having difficulty speaking. She took her husband to urgent care, but once she mentioned that he had been in contact with a pesticide, they suggested she take him to the emergency room. Once at the Emergency room they told him that his symptoms resembled that of an allergic reaction to the chemical. He was not admitted, and was feeling better since the incident.

This case is now closed.
